## Did you know?

- Northern Territory Government introduced new OH&S legislation which came into effect on 1 July 2008
- Increased responsibility on business owners and managers for workers' health and safety
- Increased penalties for not complying with legislation (up to \$13.5M)
- Increased powers to NT WorkSafe
- Introduction of elected health and safety representatives, with the power to order a worker to stop work, to represent workers in a business
- Gives unions access to businesses to investigate breaches, or alleged breaches, of the Act (under certain conditions)
